DCS Department of Child Safety (Formally known as CPS: Child Protective Services)



DCS /CPS Involvement

If DCS decides to take custody of your baby in the hospital, you may not have any options. You will be required to participate in a DCS Family Reunification Case Plan which could include the following services

- Random drug testing
- Parenting Classes
- Supervised Visitation
- Employment
- Substance Abuse Treatment
- Domestic Violence Classes
- All Court Hearings and Any Child & Family Team Meetings(CFT) for the Child.
- Psychiatric/Psychological Evaluations
- And more

DCS Department of Child Safety Continued...

Additionally, you may be required to meet with your case manager at least once a month and be given a service letter that explains every service you are supposed to be participating in.

If it is determined that you have been unsuccessful in your case plan to reunify with your child, the state may request to change the case plan to severance and adoption. At this point your child may be adopted by a foster family.
